

PLA Safety Rules

Standard Field Safety Rules:

The following rules are for the safety of the players. Those who are unable to follow these rules will be considered unsafe players and will not be welcome at future games and events.

1. Always wear eye protection in the form of goggles or full face masks. Never remove your eye protection while on the battlefield. Regular prescription glasses are NOT acceptable as safety eyewear. Must meet ANSI Z87.1 standards and wrap around the face.
2. Do not fire in the designated "safe-zones" or through them. Safe-zones include the parking area and staging area. A testing/chrono area will be marked in the parking area where weapons may be test fired in the designated direction only.
3. All replicas in safe-zones must have magazine out, safety on, muzzle cap fixed. Side arms should be holstered and on safe.
4. Do not point any weapon at anyone unless you are involved in a game on the battlefield and intend to shoot them.
5. Do not fire at any person without proper eye protection, non-participants, including animals.
6. No verbal abuse, profanity name-calling, or slurs against anyone's race, religion or family members and friends will be tolerated.
7. No illegal drug use will be permitted. No alcohol use before or during a game.
8. All "real" weapons including but not limited to firearms and fixed-blade knives are NOT allowed at games. Folding utility knives and pocket knives are allowed as an essential part of survival kit, but they may not be used in game-play.
9. Carry replicas in boxes, bags, or carrying cases while transporting gear on or off the field. Do not remove your replica from it's case near a public highway. Instead carry your gear in it's case to the designated staging area for the game.
10. Modifications to structures on the field are prohibited without prior approval.
11. Remove all of your gear and trash from the field when you leave.
